2018	Grant Burge The Holy Trinity (Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre), Barossa Valley, SA Elegant and complex with a midweighted palate that displays a combination of sweet spice, blood plum with light cocoa powder, raspberry and hints of white chocolate and nutmeg. The tannins are soft, silky and mouth coating, with a very fine texture.	100
2015	Rymill Maturation Release (Cabernet Sauvignon), Coonawarra, SA  This Maturation Release Cabernet Sauvignon is the result of a small quantity of the 2015 vintage cellared at our winery for further maturation in bottle, and only released after careful assessment. Cabernet Sauvignon is Coonawarra's pre-eminent grape variety. Parcels of premium fruit are selected, fermented and then aged in French oak barrels to produce this full bodied and richly flavoured wine.	100
2017	Angove The Medhyk Old Vine (VG) (Shiraz), McLaren Vale, SA  A collector's item. The wine is a selection of the best barrels from multiple old vineyards to make a wine of complexity and collectability—opaque purple with bright hues. Dark blackberry fruit, bitter chocolate and liquorice are aromas of dark blackberry fruit and liquorice bound by high-quality French oak. Rich and full on the front of the palate with black cherry and dark berry fruit on the middle palate.	110
2019	Penfolds BIN 128 Coonawarra (Shiraz), Coonawarra, SA  Medium-bodied Red fruits - cranberry, pomegranate, raspberry pips - a savoury edge. Creamy, naturally balanced by an interplay of acidity and extract. Madagascar vanillin and juniper enliven the package. Silky tannins (ground graphite) induce a finely-layered, powdery and almost chalky edge	120
2012	Howard Park Abercrombie (Cabernet Sauvignon), Margaret River, WA From Great Southern and Margaret River; wild-fermented and extended post-fermentation maceration; matured in French barriques (60% new) for 20 months. This is Burch Family Wines' big dog, immensely powerful and deeply structured, blackcurrant, dried herbs and grainy tannins all competing for space and attention.	120
2018	The Angelus Wirra Wirra (Cabernet Sauvignon), McLaren Vale, SA Crisp red fruits layered with autumn leaf, tilled earth and cedary characters all set a serious tone before opening up to red plum, dark cherry and black currant. Vital acidity, fruit flesh and taught, fine grained tannin build the framework for a long and elegantly structured palate.	130
2018	Yalumba The Signature (VG) (Cabernet Shiraz), Eden Valley, SA  Deep, dense purple-red in colour. Seductive and alluring florals, cool mints, red pomegranate with fine blackberry fruits and dark cherry aromas. The palate is delightfully generous with dark red cherry fruit that merges into ironstone tannins. A medium to full bodied wine with a long, flowing tannin profile.	130
2018	Henschke Keyneton Euphonium (VG) (Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot), Barossa Valley, SA  Deep crimson with vibrant ruby hues. Lifted aromas of ripe blackberry, blackcurrant, cassis, Satsuma plum, blueberry, anise and violets with hints of black pepper and cedar. Rich and concentrated flavours of dark plum, blackberry and blackcurrant, with a pure, plush and focused mid-palate, bright, balanced acidity, and excellent length, carried by fine-grained, ripe tannins.	140
